

Understanding and Ameliorating Medical Mistrust of the Healthcare System and How to Overcome It



Course Description

This course will focus on the topic of mistrust of health care providers and the health care system and operations, which has affected various racial and ethnic groups. The course will also discuss effective communication, barriers of communication as well as patient and physician engagement. The course compares and contrasts the different services rendered to communities of color compared to their counterparts. The course also examines how the COVID-19 and vaccine hesitancy was a major issue impacting black and brown communities, and why only 42% (According to the Pew Research Study, 2020) were interested in receiving the vaccine.

Objectives

- Describe the historical foundations of medical mistrust in communities of color.
- Define medical mistrust and provide examples on how it contributes to health outcomes.
- Describe the effects of medical mistrust on health care behaviors, HIV, COVID-19, and other health outcomes in communities of color.
- Discuss clinical and system-level changes that foster patient trust.
- List the skills and resources needed to interact with patients in a manner that encourages healthcare engagement and improves health outcomes.
